#### 2.) AB 366

Despite strong lobbying efforts by CACJ, CDLA, and many other groups, AB 366 appears almost certain to be passed by the California Legislature and signed by the Governor this year.

AB 366 will make ignition interlock devices (IIDs) mandatory for **all** DUI offenders (not only repeat offenders or serious first timers), effectively restoring and making permanent the current pilot/interim program scheduled to expire at the end of 2025.

The current momentum strongly favors this bill being passed, especially given:

- Unanimous legislative support so far.
- Effective framing as a priority of public safety.
- Urgency created by the pilot's upcoming expiration.
- Likely voter alignment with public safety measures in advance of next elections.

If it successfully navigates the Appropriations committee and avoids last-minute opposition or amendments, it's on track to pass the full Senate and be signed into law by Governor Newsom before the end of the 2025 session.
